**New Bike Store in Town:** Eastern Mountain Sports has moved to the new Town Center at Parole, and now has a line of bicycle gear. They're located below the Linens and Things store, just off the main traffic circle. Might be worth checking out.

**No place to work on your bike?** Check out <u>http://velocipedebikeproject.org/</u> The project has lots of tools and room for working on bikes & the project runs repair clinics. The basic program is to volunteer for 3 hours a month to use the facility that month. There are other things such as buying & trading bike parts, donating old bikes, etc.

**On travel and want to ride?** You can find shops that will rent a bike in 144 cities in the US and Canada – go to <u>www.RentaBikeNow.com</u> You can choose dates, site, bike type, etc.

**Looking for a good home for your old bike?** You can drop it off at Pedal Pushers in Severna Park (on the B&A Trail) on Saturday, May 16.
