**Rutland Road Open** Rutland Road has been reopened and is now available as a good connection to some great riding north of the Route 50/Davidsonville park and ride.

**Route 2 Maintenance** – Route 2 will soon be undergoing maintenance from Harwood road to the circle at routes 2 and 408 at Lothian. This will affect the Saturday morning rides – an alternate route to Galesville is via St. George Barber, Governor's Bridge, Riva, Beard's Point, Brick Church, South River Clubhouse, and Muddy Creek to Galesville. Alternatively, take Patuxent River and Sands through the Lothian Circle to 2 and then Nutwell or Route 258 to the Deale area.
